Emergency and public safety information

Glenburnie School has worked in accordance with Health and Safety Protocols and with support and advice from our Educational Liaison Officer from Halton Regional Police Services, and with Oakville Fire Department to develop policies and procedures for keeping Glenburnie School safe environment.

This includes:

- emergency plans and procedures (regular planned and unannounced drills for fire evacuation and lockdown)
- maps, warning signs and evacuation routes are posted throughout the school
- staff and students are trained re: drills or other emergency alerts
